Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 17/06/2008, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 25/08/2011. The Commission has made the following directions.


*"The Commission vide its proceedings dated 3.11.2010 had directed the Ministry of Home Affairs and the State Government of Tripura to take appropriate action on the suggestions submitted by the complainant, namely, (i) to provide ration, cash dole and other facilities to Bru IDP children in the six relief camps of Tripura retrospectively i.e. from the day the child was born, and (ii) to provide to State Government adequate financial assistance by the Ministry of Home Affairs as new inclusion of thousands of Bru children would mean the need for more funds for the Bru IDPs living in six relief camps.*

*In response, the Ministry of Home Affairs submitted a detailed report dated 17.1.2011 mentioning about the grant-in-aid released to the State Government. The relevant portion of the report reads as under:-*

*"Government of Tripura has informed that out of 8424 minors who were found to be staying in relief camps of Tripura during the survey conducted in the month of January to Mar, 2009, only 3129 children are getting ration and cash dole out of funds being released by Ministry of Home Affairs for maintenance of Bru migrants. State Government of Tripura is separately being advised that remaining 5295 children may also be provided ration and cash dole provided they continue to stay in relief camps of Tripura".*

*The Joint Secretary to the Government of Tripura vide his letter dated 30.7.2011 has informed that the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Government of India has allocated additional quantity of rice of 88.648 MT per month on the request of the State Government to cover the left out Bru children. Accordingly, the State Government has already taken steps to provide ration, cash dole and other facilities to the left out children w.e.f. 1.8.2011.*

*The Commission takes the report on record and closes the case."*
